

FUNDRAISING FOR MUGA

Fundraising for the MUGA is a one-off project with the specific goal of improving the school's facilities and is new territory for the current Friends of Halstow committee.

We are listening to the wishes and opinions of the school community, parents, children and teachers alike. In order to be as effective as possible, we need to be transparent about where and how donations made specifically for the MUGA will be used. The legal wording that follows allows us to do this.

The Friends of Halstow is a charity specifically set up to raise money which benefits the students at the school. We are hugely grateful for all the work that the parent body does to raise funds and run events that we all want to attend!

We want to be sure that everyone who gives to the school is as happy to donate as we are to receive their funds.

The MUGA campaign will be active until 04 June 2021.

1. If the fundraising target is not met:

1.1. For donations made after today: If the campaign falls short of the required funds, donors who have donated through CAF MUGA campaign page or sponsored donations will have the option of a refund if they so wish and if they request the same. You'll have three months from the end of the campaign to request a refund. After that time, requests may be denied if the money has been reallocated (see below re: reallocation). Alternatively, to ensure a refund, you can make a declaration at the time of your donation to friendsofhalstow@gmail.com stating you wish for the donation to be returned if the campaign fails.

This entitlement to a refund does not apply to funds raised through tickets for events and raffles or food and drink purchases, these funds will be used for the charity's general purposes, to benefit the school, if the appeal fails.

1.2. For donations made up to and including today: If any person has made a donation of any kind up to and including today, and wishes to have their donation refunded now, then please contact friendsofhalstow@gmail.com. Further, should anyone who has donated (in any format) up to and including today seek a refund in future (in the event that the target is not met), they will also have the right to a refund and should seek the same as per point (i) above.

1.3. Money that is not refunded: If the campaign fails, we will hold a vote at our AGM in September 2021 to determine how non-refunded monies will be allocated to benefit the school. This allocation exercise will be based on requests submitted by the school.

2. If the campaign raises more than required,

2.1. Those funds will be allocated to any future costs or equipment arising from, associated with, or occasioned by the MUGA.
